## Awbury Arboretum Watershed Restoration Project...

The project improves water flow to a 5-acre stream channel and wet-pond located along the west side of the arboretum's main grounds. These measures include redirecting stormwater runoff from adjacent properties, removing obstructions to the flow from two natural springs, daylighting a stretch of the spring, enhancing the existing meadow, and restoring degraded areas with native plantings.

- Environmental Education Opportunities
- Stormwater Best Management Demonstration
