Interpretive Signage at CSO Outfall Areas...

PWD has designed and produced 12 signs, with text in both English and Spanish, that indicate the location of Combined Sewer outfalls. The signs warn about the hazards of contact with the water. Locations for placement of these signs were selected based on factors such as high visibility, known recreational areas, and volume of the combined sewer overflow. The sign reads:

No Swimming at Any Time - Sewer Overflows
