Interpretive Signage at Tacony Creek Roadway Crossings...

Signs identifying the creek were placed immediately before each side of 5 stream crossings on state-owned roadways in the Tacony-Frankford Watershed. These signs aim to promote awareness about the need to protect and preserve this vital watershed. The 5 sites were located at:

- Roosevelt Boulevard between F Street and Bingham Street
- Adams Avenue between Newtown Avenue and Crescentville Road
- Whitaker Avenue between Wyoming Avenue and Ruscomb Street
- Frankford Avenue between Torresdale Avenue & Hunting Park Avenue
- Torresdale Avenue between Hunting Park Avenue & Frankford Avenue

- Helps residents and visitors learn the names of local streams
