Tacony Creek Stream Restoration: Adams Ave to Tabor Ave Bridge -- Reach 1...

Tookany/Tacony-Frankford is an urban stream system that has been adversely affected by development and land use practices over the past century. Its streams are very flashy. Increases in streamflow and erosive forces occur almost immediately following the onset of storm events. Changes in hydrology have resulted in de-stabilization of much of the watershed. This project proposal is for riparian and stream restoration. In addition to the stream restoration focus component of this project, its scope will also include potential wetland creation/enhancement/restoration opportunities.
