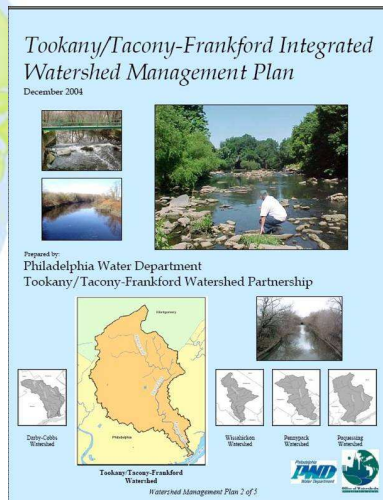

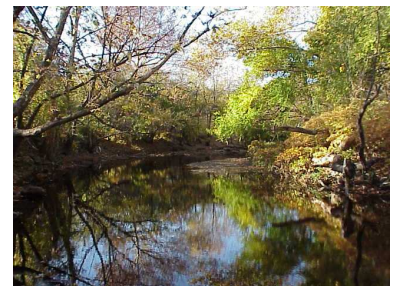

Tacony-Frankford Watershed Management Plan Implementation Projects...

In 2004, the TTF Watershed Partnership completed a multi-year planning process under the leadership of the PWD, resulting in the TTF Integrated Watershed Management Plan. This watershed-wide plan is based on several years of data collection and analysis, which identify water quality and quantity problems and make recommendations for alleviating these issues. The management plan is designed to restore beneficial uses of the waterways and riparian areas, to mitigate the adverse impacts of surrounding land uses, and to improve the environmental health and safe enjoyment of the TTF. The PWD has utilized the recommendations from this management plan to develop an implementation plan and restoration projects for the watershed which are currently in progress.



Benefits:

- Meet water quality standards in the stream during dry and wet weather flows
- Elimination of sources of sewage discharge during dry weather
- Improvements to the number, health, and diversity of the benthic invertebrate and fish species in the TTF
- Stormwater BMP implementation
- Stream bed and bank stabilization
- Trash removal and litter prevention
- Demonstrates a model approach for watershed-wide stream restoration
