*PUBLIC MEETING GOAL PRIORITIZATION LIST*

Based on five public outreach meetings, goal prioritization combined rankings follow:

- 35 Protect existing green corridors and promote new green corridors through easements, land acquisition and donations.
- 28 Enforce floodplain protection ordinances.
- 24 Educate builders and municipal officials about reducing impacts on water resources.
- 19 Restore streambank stability through natural stream channel restoration projects.
- 18 Restore creek-side habitats by planting native plant species.
- 16 Improve in-stream habitats through dam removal and habitat enhancement projects.
- 16 Implement aggressive monitoring program to track sewer infrastructure leaks.
- 14 Adopt consistent natural resource protection ordinances for all watershed municipalities.
- 10 Develop invasive species management plans for natural areas and parks.
- 10 Monitor successes of habitat and species restoration efforts.
- 9 Create an organization or other mechanism for plan implementation.
- 5 Improve stream access, especially in upper watershed where connection to stream is lost.
- 5 Develop watershed-wide open space/creek-side corridor protection plan.
- 3 Develop site map and informational materials of best examples of restoration and management for municipalities and developers.
- 2 Develop comprehensive streambank and stream channel assessment.
